

John 18:10~ Then Simon Peter, as he had a sword, drew it, and struck the slave of the High Priest, and cut his right ear off. The name of the slave was Malchus.

- 1· Then Peter, who was near to Jesus, struck out with his sword, upon seeing what was going to happen, and he struck the slave of the High Priest, and cut off his right ear. The name of that slave was Malchus.

[Question] What then, did Peter do to try to protect Jesus from the one arresting Jesus?

[Question] What was the name of the slave, whom Peter struck, removing his right ear?

- 2· But, look! One of those with Jesus reached out his hand and drew his sword, and struck the slave of the High Priest and took off his ear. (Matthew 26:51)

[Question] Who then, took up his sword to try to defend Jesus, and what resulted?

- 3· However, a certain one of those standing by drew his sword, and struck the slave of the High Priest, and took his ear off. (Mark 14:47)

[Question] What did Peter then do, and what resulted for the slave of the High Priest, Malchus?

- 4· A certain one of them even did strike the slave of the High Priest, and took off his right ear. (Luke 22:50)

[Question] What happened when Peter drew his sword, and what harm did he cause, and to whom?

- 5· One of the slaves of the High Priest, being a relative of the man whose ear Peter cut off, said; I saw you in the garden with him, did I not? (John 18:26)

[Question] What did a relative of this slave later say to Peter, while in the courtyard of the High Priest's house?
