

John 18:13~

And they led him first to Annas, for he was father-in-law to Caiaphas, who was High Priest that year.

- 1· **At first Jesus was led to the house of Annas, who was the father-in-law of Caiaphas, who was the High Priest then.**

[Question] Where then, did they lead Jesus first, and why there?

- 2· **Those who took Jesus into custody led him away to Caiaphas, the High Priest, where the scribes and the older men were gathered together. (Matthew 26:57)**

[Question] Where later did they take Jesus, for who was gathered together there?

- 3· **In the days of chief priest Annas and of Caiaphas, God's declaration came to John, the son of Zechariah, in the wilderness. (Luke 3:2)**

[Question] Who was chief priest, when John the Baptist began his ministry?

- 4· **Then Annas sent him away bound to Caiaphas the High Priest. (John 18:24)**

[Question] Where did Annas send Jesus to, and how?

- 5· **Also Annas the chief priest and Caiaphas and John and Alexander, and as many as were of the chief priest's kinsfolk. (Acts of Apostles 4:6)**

[Question] Who later met together, over a healing performed by Peter and John?

- 6· **Then the chief priests and the older men of the people gathered together in the courtyard of the High Priest who was called Caiaphas. (Matthew 26:3)**

[Question] In the courtyard of whose house, did they then gather together?

- 7· **They now led Jesus away to the High Priest, and all the chief priests and the older men and the scribes assembled. (Mark 14:53)**

[Question] Where did they then lead Jesus to, and who was assembled together there?
