

**John 18:16~** But Peter was standing outside at the door. Therefore the other disciple, who was known to the High Priest, went out and spoke to the doorkeeper, and brought Peter in.

1· But Peter remained standing outside near the door. So the other disciple who was known to the High Priest, after gaining permission, went out to the door where Peter was standing, and let him into the courtyard, in view of what was going on.

[Question] Where did Peter remain, upon first arriving there?

[Question] How did he later gain entry to the inner courtyard?

2· Now Peter was sitting outside in the courtyard, and a servant girl came up to him, saying; You, too, were with Jesus the Galilean! (Matthew 26:69)

[Question] Who then approached Peter, while he was warming himself by the fire?

3· Now while Peter was below in the courtyard, one of the servant girls of the High Priest came. (Mark 14:66)

[Question] Who came up to Peter while he was sitting in the courtyard?

4· But Peter kept following him at a good distance, as far as the courtyard of the High Priest, and, after going inside, he was sitting with the house attendants to see the outcome. (Matthew 26:58)

[Question] How far did Peter go in following Jesus, and where did he sit down, once he gained access?
