3. Get up, let us go. Look! My betrayer has drawn near. (Mark 14:42)

[Question] What did Jesus say, when he saw Judas Iscariot approaching with a crowd of men?

4' While he was yet speaking, look! A crowd, and the man called Judas, one of the twelve, was going before them, and he approached Jesus to kiss him. (Luke 22:47)

[Question] Who was leading the crowd, who came out to the garden to arrest Jesus in the middle of the night?

[Ouestion] What did Judas Iscariot do, upon approaching Jesus then?
