- 2· On going out he went as customarily to the Mount of Olives, and the **disciples** also followed him. (Luke 22:39)**

[Question] Where was it Jesus' custom to spend the night when in Jerusalem?

- 3· Get up, let us go. Look! My **betrayer** has drawn near. (Mark 14:42)**

[Question] What did Jesus say, when he saw Judas Iscariot approaching with a crowd of men?

- 4· While he was yet speaking, look! A crowd, and the man called Judas, one of the twelve, was going before them, and he approached **Jesus** to kiss him. (Luke 22:47)**

[Question] Who was leading the crowd, who came out to the garden to arrest Jesus in the middle of the night?

[Question] What did Judas Iscariot do, upon approaching Jesus then?
