John 18:26~ One of the slaves of the High Priest, being a relative of the man whose ear Peter cut off, said; I saw you in the garden with him, did I not?

1. Next one of the slaves of the High Priest who was a relative of Malchus, the slave whose right ear Peter had taken off, said; I saw you in the garden with him, did I not?

[Question] Who next accused Peter, and why did this man take particular note of Peter in the garden of Gethsemane?

2. Then Simon Peter, as he had a sword, drew it and struck the slave of the High Priest and cut his right ear off. The name of the slave was Malchus. (John 18:10)

[Question] Who had taken the ear of the slave of the High Priest off with his sword, and what was that slave's name?

3. After a little while those standing around came up and said to Peter; Certainly you also are one of them, for, in fact, your dialect gives you away. (Matthew 26:73)

[Question] What did those standing around with Peter say to him again after a time, for what gave him away as being one of Jesus' disciples?

4. And after about an hour intervened a certain other man began insisting strongly; For a certainty this man also was with him, for, in fact, he is a Galilean! (Luke 22:59)

[Question] When then, did another man begin to insist strongly regarding Peter?
