

John 18:27~ However, Peter denied it again, and immediately a cock crowed.

- 1· However Peter denied being one of Jesus' disciples again, a third time, and as soon as he did so, a cock crowed.

[Question] What did Peter say in response to this man, and what then happened immediately?

- 2· Then he started to curse and swear; I do not know the man! And **immediately a cock crowed.** (**Matthew 26:74**)

[Question] How did Peter respond very strongly to this man's accusations, and then what happened in fulfillment of Jesus' words spoken earlier?

- 3· And **immediately a cock crowed** a second time, and Peter recalled the saying that Jesus spoke to him; Before a **cock** crows twice, you will disown me three times. And he broke down and gave way to weeping. (**Mark 14:72**)

[Question] What then happened a second time, and what did this bring to Peter's mind with forcefulness?

[Question] How then did Peter feel, and what did he do?

- 4· But Peter said; Man, I do not know what you are saying. And instantly, while he was yet speaking, a **cock crowed.** (**Luke 22:60**)

[Question] How did Peter respond to this man, and what happened while he was yet speaking?

- 5· Jesus answered; Will you surrender your soul in my behalf? Most truly I say to you, a **cock** will by no means crow, until you have disowned me three times. (**John 13:38**)

[Question] What had Jesus earlier told Peter, that he would do later that night?
