

John 18:3~ Therefore Judas took the soldier band, and officers of the chief priests and of the Pharisees, and came there with torches and lamps and weapons.

- 1· Therefore Judas led a band of men including soldiers, and officers of the chief priests and of the Pharisees, and they came there with torches and lamps and weapons, to the garden, to arrest Jesus.

[Question] Who came out to arrest Jesus, and who was with them, and what were they carrying?

- 2· And while he was yet speaking, look! Judas, one of the twelve, **came**, and with him a great crowd with swords and clubs, from the **chief priests** and older men of the people. (**Matthew 26:47**)

[Question] What happened while Jesus was yet speaking to Peter in the garden?

[Question] How was this crowd outfitted, and who had sent them?

- 3· And immediately, while he was yet speaking, Judas, one of the twelve, arrived, and with him a crowd with swords and clubs, from the **chief priests** and the scribes and the older men. (**Mark 14:43**)

[Question] What kind of a crowd came out to arrest Jesus, and who was leading them to Jesus?

- 4· Men, brothers, it was necessary for the scripture to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by David's mouth, about Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus. (**Acts of Apostles 1:16**)

[Question] How did Peter later testify about how King David in the Psalms had prophesied about unfaithful Judas Iscariot, and his betrayal of Jesus?

- 5· Day and night they go round about it upon its walls, and hurtfulness and trouble are within it. (**Psalms 55:10**)

[Question] What did the Psalmist show, about the men of the city of Jerusalem?
