## **1**. This they said to bring fulfillment to Jesus words, about what sort of death he was destined to experience at their hands.

**[Question]** What were these Jews determined to do to Jesus, whether it was just or unjust to do so?

2. And will deliver him up to men of the nations to make fun of, and to scourge, and to impale, and the third day, he will be raised up. (Matthew 20:19)

**[Question]** What did Jesus earlier prophesy about his upcoming confrontation with these men of the nations?

3. And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so the Son of man must be lifted up. (John 3:14)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that they must do to him in faith to gain salvation, like what earlier occurrence in the wilderness?

4 And yet I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw men of all sorts to me. (John 12:32)

**[Question]** What would Jesus himself do for others putting faith in him, after his resurrection to spirit life in heaven?

5. This he was really saying to signify what sort of death he was about to die. (John 12:33)

**[Question]** What did Jesus earlier say about his upcoming death, showing that it was not to be permanent?
