John 18:33~ So Pilate entered into the governor's palace again, and called Jesus, and said to him; Are you the king of the Jews?

1. So Pilate entered again into his palace, away from the Jews, and he called Jesus to appear before him, and he posed the question to him; Was Jesus the king of the Jews? For Pilate was aware of the events of the past few days, and of Jesus' entry to Jerusalem several days earlier, he then being hailed as the king of the Jews by many.

[Question] What question did Pilate again ask of Jesus, for what events of the past week in Jerusalem was he certainly aware of?

2. Jesus now stood before the governor, and the governor put the question to him; Are you the king of the Jews? Jesus replied; You yourself say it. (Matthew 27:11)

[Question] What question did Pilate then ask of Jesus, and how did Jesus answer him?

3. Took the branches of palm trees, and went out to meet him. And they began to shout; Save, we pray you! Blessed is he that comes in Yehowah's name, even the king of Israel! (John 12:13)

[Question] How had Jesus been hailed earlier that week upon entering Jerusalem?

4. So Pilate put the question to him; Are you the king of the Jews? In answer to him he said; You yourself say it. (Mark 15:2)

[Question] What question did Pilate ask of Jesus, and how did Jesus answer it, showing what?
