John 18:35~ Pilate answered; I am not a Jew, am I? Your own nation and the chief priests delivered you up to me. What did you do?

1. So Pilate answered, that he was not a Jew, and so what interest would he personally have in the Jews' matters? Then he told Jesus that Jesus' own nation and the chief priests were the ones that had delivered him up to him. So he asked him; What did he do?

[Question] How then did Pilate answer Jesus' question, showing what?

[Question] Who did Pilate show had accused Jesus falsely, and so what did Pilate want to know about Jesus' actions?

2. He came to his own home, but his own people did not take him in. (John 1:11)

[Question] Where was Jesus ministry focused upon, and yet how was he received?
