Jesus answered; My kingdom is no part of this world. If my kingdom were part of this world, my attendants would have fought, that I should not be delivered up to the Jews. But as it is, my kingdom is not from this source.

1. So then, Jesus answered his first question, as to whether he was king of the Jews. He told Pilate, that his Kingdom, was no part of this world, for if it had been, then his disciples would have readily fought to defend it. Yet the truth was, that his Kingdom was not from this source.

[Question] What question did Jesus then address first, and how did he answer Pilate?

[Question] How did Jesus even show, that his Kingdom was no part of this world?

2. In the sight of God, who preserves all things alive, and of Christ Jesus, who as a witness made the fine public declaration before Pontius Pilate, I give you orders. (1 Timothy 6:13)

[Question] What did Paul later testify that Jesus made when before Pilate?

3. For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)

[Question] What son was prophesied to come forth to Israel, and what would be upon his shoulders to carry for the people?

[Question] What future roles would this one play toward all of God's people?

4. And in the days of those kings, the God of heaven will set up a kingdom, that will never be brought to ruin. And the kingdom itself will not be passed on to any other people. It will crush, and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it itself, will stand to times indefinite. (Daniel 2:44)

[Question] What Kingdom had Yehowah God promised to set up for all mankind earthwide?

[Question] What will this kingdom do toward all other kingdoms existing when it takes up its power to rule the earth?

5. And to him, there were given rulership and dignity and kingdom, that the peoples, national groups and languages, should all serve even him. His rulership is an indefinitely lasting rulership, that will not pass away, and his kingdom, one, that will not be brought to ruin. (Daniel 7:14)

[Question] What is given to the Son of Man in the vision of Daniel, and how long will his rulership of the earth last?

6. Or do you think, that I cannot appeal to my Father to supply me at this moment, more than twelve legions of angels? (Matthew 26:53)

[Question] What power did Jesus confess to Peter, that he possessed at any given time?

7. Jesus, however, said to Peter; Put the sword into its sheath. The cup that the Father has given me, should I not by all means drink it? (John 18:11)

[Question] What though, did Jesus want to accomplish, even if it meant giving up his life?

8. He said to him; Man, who appointed me judge or apportioner over you persons? (Luke 12:14)

[Question] What did Jesus show, that he was not then, toward the people of Israel?

9. Therefore he said; A certain man of noble birth traveled to a distant land, to secure kingly power for himself, and to return. (Luke 19:12)

[Question] How did Jesus illustrate, what he himself was about to do?

10" Then they started to accuse him, saying; This man we found subverting our nation, and forbidding the paying of taxes to Caesar, and saying; He himself is Christ, a king. (Luke 23:2)

[Question] How did the Jews falsely accuse Jesus of breaking the Roman's laws?

11. Therefore Jesus, knowing they were about to come and seize him to make him king, withdrew again into the mountain all alone. (John 6:15)

[Question] Was Jesus desirous of becoming an earthly king then, and how did he show this?

12. So he went on to say to them; You are from the realms below. I am from the realms above. You are from this world. I am not from this world. (John 8:23)

[Question] Where did Jesus life originate, yet where do most men's lives originate?

13. They are no part of the world, just as I am no part of the world. (John 17:16)

[Question] What was Jesus respecting this world, ruled by Satan the Devil?

14. As for us, our citizenship exists in the heavens, from which place also, we are eagerly waiting for a savior, the Lord Jesus Christ. (Philippians 3:20)

[Question] Where does the citizenship of spirit anointed Christians rest, now that they have been reborn through the Holy Spirit?

15. He delivered us from the authority of the darkness, and transferred us, into the kingdom, of the Son of his love. (Colossians 1:13)

[Question] What authority did Jesus deliver his disciples from, and whose authority are they now under?

16. Adulteresses, do you not know that the friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever, therefore, wants to be a friend of the world, is constituting himself an enemy of God. (James 4:4)

[Question] What does friendship with the world make one, who desires it?

[Question] What is anyone wanting to become a friend of the current worldly system of things, make of himself before Yehowah God?

17. And I saw another wild beast ascending out of the earth, and it had two horns like a lamb, but it began speaking as a dragon. (Revelation 13:11)

[Question] What wild beast is described in Revelation, and how does it speak and act, yet what is its appearance, so as to deceive?
