John 18:37~ Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying, that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness¹ to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth, listens to my voice.

Footnote: I should bear witness Greek, mar·ty·re'so; Latin, te·sti·mo'ni·um per·hi'be·am

1. So Pilate then asked him if he was a king. However Jesus answered, that Pilate and others, were the ones saying that he was a king, inferring, that he himself was not making such a claim. Yet he also showed Pilate, that the reason he had come into this world was that he should bear witness to the truth. Then he told Pilate, that everyone who is on the side of the truth, listens to his voice.

[Question] What then, did Pilate ask of Jesus?

[Question] Who did Jesus answer this question, and how did he show that others were the ones inferring this?

[Question] What did Jesus then show, was the real reason why he had come forth into the world, and so who listens to his voice and teachings?

2. Jesus said to him; You yourself said it. Yet I say to you men, From henceforth you will see the Son of man sitting at the right hand of power, and coming on the clouds of heaven. (Matthew 26:64)

[Question] How did Jesus answer the High Priest when asked the same question earlier, and what did he say, that those men would later come to see?

3. Jesus now stood before the governor, and the governor put the question to him; Are you the king of the Jews? Jesus replied; You yourself say it. (Matthew 27:11)

[Question] What question did Pilate now ask of Jesus, and how did Jesus answer it?

4. So the Word became flesh, and resided among us, and we had a view of his glory, a glory such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth. (John 1:14)

[Question] Who was Jesus known as in heaven, before coming to the earth?

[Question] When he came to the earth, what was he full of from Yehowah God?

5 Because the Law was given through Moses, the undeserved kindness and the truth, came to be through Jesus Christ. (John 1:17)

[Question] What came to the people through Moses, and what better things come through Jesus Christ?

6. Jesus said to him; I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father, except through me. (John 14:6)

[Question] What did Jesus say of himself to his disciples?

[Question] Can anyone come to the Father except through him?

[Question] What does this mean for the Jews as a people?

7. And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. (John 8:32)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that they would come to know, and then, what would this release them from?

8. By this we shall know that we originate with the truth, and we shall assure our hearts before him (1 John 3:19)

[Question] What does loving in deed and truth prove to spirit anointed Christians?

9. We originate with God. He that gains the knowledge of God, listens to us. He that does not originate with God, does not listen to us. This is how we take note, of the inspired expression of truth, and the inspired expression of error. (1 John 4:6)

[Question] Who listens to the sayings of true spirit anointed Christians, and who does not listen?

[Question] How then, do true spirit anointed Christians take note of the false inspired expression of error?

10" Who of you convicts me of sin? If I speak truth, why is it you do not believe me? (John 8:46)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his Jewish listeners, that he always spoke, and what did he ask of them?

11. And I shall put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head, and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)

[Question] What would exist down through time between the seed of Satan the Devil, and the seed of the woman, Jesus Christ?

12. And upon him, the spirit of Yehowah must settle down, the spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the spirit of counsel and of mightiness, the spirit of knowledge, and of the fear of Yehowah. (Isaiah 11:2)

[Question] What so would settle down upon Jesus Christ, the Messiah of God, as Isaiah prophesied?

13. And Yehowah says; For the reason that this people have come near with their mouth, and they have glorified me merely with their lips, and they have removed their heart itself far away from me, and their fear toward me, becomes men's commandment that is being taught. (Isaiah 29:13)

[Question] What was the spiritual situation or condition of the Jews, that Isaiah prophesied about?

14. Listen to me, you the ones knowing righteousness, the people in whose heart is my Law. Do not be afraid of the reproach of mortal men, and do not be struck with terror, just because of their abusive words. (Isaiah 51:7)

[Question] How did Isaiah counsel those knowing righteousness, and what should they not be afraid of?

15. Look! As a witness to the national groups I have given him, as a leader and commander to the national groups. (Isaiah 55:4)

[Question] What was Jesus given to the nation of Israel as, and where also would be become a witness for Yehowah God?

16. He that is from God, listens to the sayings of God. This is why you do not listen, because you are not from God. (John 8:47)

[Question] What does the one from Yehowah God listen to?

[Question] What does it tell spirit anointed Christians, when someone refuses to listen to fine scriptural counsel from the Bible?

17. To these we did not yield by way of submission, no, not for an hour, in order, that the truth of the Good News, might continue with you. (Galatians 2:5)

[Question] To whom did Paul refuse to yield in his teachings, and why?

18. Indeed, the sacred secret of this godly devotion is admittedly great. He was made manifest in flesh, was declared righteous in spirit, appeared to angels, was preached about among nations, was believed upon in the world, was received up in glory. (1 Timothy 3:16)

[Question] What sacred secret did Paul show had become great among the nations of the earth?

19. And to the angel of the congregation in Laodicea write.
These are the things that the Amen says, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation by God.
(Revelation 3:14)

[Question] How is Jesus Christ described in the Revelation account?

20" Look! I am standing at the door and knocking. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come into his house, and take the evening meal with him, and he with me. (Revelation 3:20)

[Question] What promise does Jesus make to anyone hearing his figurative knock at the door?

21. To the one that conquers, I will grant to sit down with me on my throne, even as I conquered, and sat down with my Father on his throne. (Revelation 3:21)

[Question] What privilege does Jesus Christ reserve for anyone conquering this wicked world?

22. And when he opened the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar, the souls of those slaughtered because of the word of God, and because of the witness work, that they used to have. (Revelation 6:9)

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[Question] What vision of slaughtered ones is seen in the Revelation vision, and why are they there?

23. And no falsehood was found in their mouths, they are without blemish. (Revelation 14:5)

[Question] What is also said about these faithful witnesses?
