John 18:38~ Pilate said to him; What is truth? And after saying this, he went out again to the Jews, and said to them; I find no fault in him.

1. So Pilate answered; What is truth? Then after saying this, he went outside, and again spoke to the Jews, and said to them, that he found no fault in this man.

[Question] How though, did Pilate answer Jesus, he not being a Jew?[Question] Where then did he go, and what did he tell the religious leaders?

2. Seeing that it did no good but, rather, an uproar was arising, Pilate took water and washed his hands before the crowd, saying; I am innocent of the blood of this man. You yourselves must see to it. (Matthew 27:24)

[Question] What did Pilate do when the crowds refused to stop calling for Jesus' death?

3. Then Pilate said to the chief priests and the crowds; I find no crime in this man. (Luke 23:4)

[Question] What did Pilate repeatedly say, to the Jews accusing Jesus?

4. But it is, that the word written in their Law may be fulfilled: They hated me without cause. (John 15:25)

[Question] Why did these things have to happen to Jesus, and was there any sound reason for their hatred of Jesus Christ?

5. So he said to them: Yehowah is a witness against you, and his anointed one is a witness this day, that you have found nothing at all in my hand. To this they said; He is a witness. (1 Samuel 12:5)

[Question] How did Samuel testify as to his own righteousness before all Israel?

6. And said to them; You brought this man to me as one inciting the people to revolt, and, look! I examined him in front of you, but found in this man no grounds, for the charges you are bringing against him. (Luke 23:14)
