

**John 18:5~** They answered him; Jesus the Nazarene. He said to them; **I am he.** Now Judas, his betrayer, was also standing with them.

- 1· When they answered, that they were looking for Jesus the Nazarene, he answered that he was the one they were looking for. Also Judas his betrayer was standing by.

**[Question]** How did the mob then answer Jesus' question, and how did he respond?

- 2· And came and dwelt in a city named Nazareth, that there might be fulfilled what was spoken through the prophets: He will be called a Nazarene. (**Matthew 2:23**)

**[Question]** Why was it necessary for Jesus Christ to be raised in Nazareth, though born in Bethlehem?

- 3· Saying; What have we to do with you, Jesus you Nazarene? Did you come to destroy us? I know exactly who you are, the Holy One of God. (**Mark 1:24**)

**[Question]** What did the demons say to Jesus disparagingly, when ordered to come out of people?

- 4· When he heard that it was Jesus the Nazarene, he started shouting and saying; Son of David, Jesus, have mercy on me! (**Mark 10:47**)

**[Question]** Whose son was Jesus well known to be?

- 5· And, seeing Peter warming himself, she looked straight at him and **said**; You, too, were with the Nazarene, this Jesus. (**Mark 14:67**)

**[Question]** What was Peter later accused of being a disciples of?

- 6· While he was yet speaking, look! A crowd, and the man called **Judas**, one of the twelve, was going before them, and he approached Jesus to kiss him. (**Luke 22:47**)

**[Question]** What then, happened while Jesus, was yet speaking to Peter?

**[Question]** How did Judas Iscariot approach Jesus then?

- 7· I answered; Who are you, Lord? And he **said** to me; **I am** Jesus the Nazarene, whom you are persecuting. (**Acts of**

**Apostles 22:8)**
