

John 18:9~ In order, that the word might be fulfilled which he said: **Of those whom you have given me, I have not lost a single one.**

1· This he said in order for the scriptures to be fulfilled that: Of those that were given to me, I have not lost a single one.

[Question] What scripture hung in the balance of being properly fulfilled, should one of his disciples be hurt or killed?

2· This is the will of him that sent me, that I should lose nothing out of all that he has given me, but that I should resurrect it at the last day. (John 6:39)

[Question] What is the will of Yehowah God, respecting all those he has given to his Son, Jesus Christ?

3· When I was with them I used to watch over them on account of your own name which you have given me, and I have kept them, and not one of them is destroyed, except the son of destruction, in order, that the scripture might be fulfilled. (John 17:12)

[Question] What did Jesus earlier show, that he had done for his disciples while among them, and what resulted?

4· And I give them everlasting life, and they will by no means ever be destroyed, and no one will snatch them out of my hand. (John 10:28)

[Question] What did Jesus give to his disciples, and could anyone snatch them out of his control, or hand of protection?

5· These will battle with the Lamb, but, because he is Lord of lords and King of kings, the Lamb will conquer them. Also, those called and chosen and faithful with him will do so. (Revelation 17:14)

[Question] How will those ones later fare who choose to fight against the glorified Jesus Christ, and his 144,000 faithful ones?
