

John 19:10~ Hence Pilate said to him; Are you not speaking to me? Do you not know, I have authority to release you, and I have authority to impale you?

- 1· So Pilate got agitated over Jesus' failure to answer him, and he asked Jesus, if he understood, that he had the authority to either let him go, or to kill him.

[Question] What did Pilate say, threatening Jesus, showing that Jesus refusal to answer him was annoying him?

- 2· Now he began to question him with a good many words, but he made him no answer. (**Luke 23:9**)

[Question] What did Pilate now do towards Jesus, and how did Jesus respond to his many questions?

- 3· It is in the power of my hand to do harm to you people, but the God of your father talked to me last night, saying; Watch yourself against **speaking** either good or bad with Jacob. (**Genesis 31:29**)

[Question] How had Yehowah God earlier defended Jacob his servant, from Laban?

- 4· Woe to those who are scheming what is harmful, and to those practicing what is bad, upon their beds! By the light of the morning they proceed to do it, because it is in the power of their hand. (**Micah 2:1**)

[Question] What do men who scheme wicked things in the night, often do the next day?

- 5· Now Pilate began questioning him again, saying; Have you no reply to make? See, how many charges they are bringing against you. (**Mark 15:4**)

[Question] How did Pilate come to feel, when Jesus made no response to him repeatedly?

- 6· Hence Pilate **said** to them; Take him yourselves and judge him according to your Law. The Jews **said** to him; It is not lawful for us to kill anyone. (**John 18:31**)

[Question] What did Pilate then give authority to the Jews, to do themselves?
