John 19:14~ Now it was preparation of the Passover, it was about the sixth hour. And he said to the Jews; See! Your king!

Footnote: That is, about 12 noon, counting from sunrise

1. Now it was preparation of the Passover and it was about noon time, and so he said to the Jews; See! Your king!

[Question] What day was it to the Jews, and what time of day was it?[Question] What did Pilate then say to the assembled Jews?

2. The next day, which was after the Preparation, the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered together before Pilate. (Matthew 27:62)

[Question] When did some of the Jews assemble before Pilate, concerned over securing the gravesite of Jesus Christ?

3. Then the Jews, since it was Preparation, in order, that the bodies might not remain upon the torture stakes on the Sabbath, for the day of that Sabbath was a great one, requested Pilate to have their legs broken, and the bodies taken away. (John 19:31)

[Question] What did the Jews request later that day, for what was approaching, and where could they not leave the bodies on the Sabbath?

4. There, then, on account of the preparation of the Jews, they laid Jesus, because the memorial tomb was nearby. (John 19:42)

[Question] Where was Jesus laid temporarily, immediately following his death, and why?
