John 19:17~ And, bearing the torture stake¹ for himself, he went out to the so-called Skull Place,² which is called *Golgotha*³ in Hebrew.

1. So then Jesus started out by bearing the torture stake for himself and they led him to the place of impalement, which was called Skull Place, or in Hebrew *Golgotha*.

[Question] Where did the soldiers then take Jesus, for the actual impaling of him?

2. After that Abraham took the wood of the burnt offering, and put it upon Isaac his son, and took in his hands the fire and the slaughtering knife, and both of them went on together. (Genesis 22:6)

[Question] How did Abraham and Isaac enact a prophetic drama depicting what Yehowah God and his son Jesus Christ were now doing before Israel?

3. As they were going out they found a native of Cyrene named Simon. This man they impressed into service, to lift up his torture stake. (Matthew 27:32)

[Question] Who did they find to carry the torture stake of Jesus, since he was weakened after being whipped?

4. However, he will have the bull of the sin offering and the goat of the sin offering, the blood of both of which was brought in to make atonement in the holy place, taken forth outside the camp, and they must burn their skins and their flesh and their dung in the fire. (Leviticus 16:27)

[Question] What patterns were within the Law Covenant, that depicted this atonement before God?

5. Hence Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered outside the gate. (Hebrews 13:12)

[Question] Where then, did Jesus suffer, and how did he sanctify the people?

6. And when they came to a place called *Golgotha*, that is to say, Skull Place. (Matthew 27:33)

[Question] Where did they take Jesus for impaling?

7. So they brought him to the place *Golgotha*, which means, when translated, Skull Place. (Mark 15:22)

[Question] What does the Hebrew term *Golgotha* mean?

8. Now as they led him away, they laid hold of Simon, a certain native of Cyrene, coming from the country, and they placed the torture stake upon him, to bear it behind Jesus. (Luke 23:26)

[Question] Who did the soldiers impress into service, to carry the torture stake for Jesus, and why was this necessary?
