1· Also nailed to his torture stake was a plaque stating in three languages; Jesus the Nazarene, the King of the Jews.

2· Also, they posted above his head the charge against him, in writing; This is Jesus, the King of the Jews. (Matthew 27:37)

[Question] What was the charge Pilate attached to the torture stake, to show why Jesus was being killed?

3· And the inscription of the charge against him was written above, The King of the Jews. (Mark 15:26)

[Question] What was the charge for which Jesus was put to death?

4· There was also an inscription over him; This is the king of the Jews. (Luke 23:38)

[Question] What did the inscription over Jesus head read, as the charge against him?

5· Ah! What have we to do with you, Jesus you Nazarene? Did you come to destroy us? I know exactly who you are, the Holy One of God. (Luke 4:34)

[Question] How did the demons many times refer to Jesus, and what did they know about him, that mere men did not know?
