

**John 19:2~** And the soldiers braided a crown of thorns, and put it on his head, and arrayed him with a purple outer garment.

1· Then the soldiers, into whose charge he was placed, braided a crown of thorns, and put this upon his head, and draped him with a purple outer garment, mocking him, that he was the king of the Jews, a people who would rather see him dead.

**[Question]** What did the soldiers then do to Jesus, and how did they treat him?

2· And they braided a crown out of thorns, and put it on his head, and a reed in his right hand. And, kneeling before him, they made fun of him, saying: Good day, you King of the Jews! (**Matthew 27:29**)

**[Question]** How did the soldiers then mock Jesus, as the king of Israel?

3· And they decked him with purple, and braided a crown of thorns, and put it on him. (**Mark 15:17**)

**[Question]** What did they outfit him with, to mock his kingship?

4· Then Herod, together with his soldier guards, discredited him, and he made fun of him by clothing him with a bright garment, and sent him back to Pilate. (**Luke 23:11**)

**[Question]** How did Herod later treat Jesus, when Jesus refused to speak to Herod, or answer his questions?

5· And disrobing him, they draped him with a scarlet cloak. (**Matthew 27:28**)

**[Question]** What did the soldiers drape over Jesus, and what did this mock about Jesus?
