John 19:23~ Now when the soldiers had impaled Jesus, they took his outer garments and made four parts, for each soldier a part, and the inner garment. But the inner garment was without a seam, being woven from the top throughout its length.

1. Now when the soldiers impaled Jesus they took his outer garments, dividing them up into four parts, one for each soldier. But they kept the inner garment separate from this division, for it was a fine quality garment, one without a seam, being woven from top to bottom as one piece.

[Question] What did the soldiers now do to Jesus' garments once they impaled him?

[Question] Why did they not want to tear the inner garment, and so how did they decide who got this garment?

2. When they had impaled him they distributed his outer garments by casting lots. (Matthew 27:35)

[Question] How did the soldiers decide, who received Jesus inner garment?

3. And they impaled him, and distributed his outer garments by casting the lot over them, as to who takes what. (Mark 15:24)

[Question] How did the soldiers decide, who would get his fine inner garment?

4. But Jesus was saying; Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing. Furthermore, to distribute his garments, they cast lots. (Luke 23:34)

[Question] What did Jesus say to his heavenly Father regarding those killing him?

[Question] Who did the soldiers decide, how to distribute his inner garment?
