John 19:3~ And they began coming up to him and saying; Good day, you King of the Jews! Also, they would give him slaps in the face.

1. So they would come up before him, mocking his regal form and saying; Good day you king of the Jews. Also they would slap him in the face, and hit him.

[Question] How then, would the soldiers address Jesus, and what did they show no respect for?

2. He was despised, and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains, and for having acquaintance with sickness. And there was as if the concealing of one's face from us. He was despised, and we held him, as of no account. (Isaiah 53:3)

[Question] How did Isaiah earlier prophesy, about how men of his generation would view the Messiah, Jesus Christ?

3. At this time you make cuttings upon yourself, O daughter of an invasion, a siege he has laid against us. With the rod, they will strike upon the cheek, the judge of Israel. (Micah 5:1)

[Question] How did Micah prophesy, about who they would strike upon the cheek with the rod?

4. Then they spit into his face and hit him with their fists. Others slapped him in the face. (Matthew 26:67)

[Question] How had Jesus earlier been treated by those around the High Priest?

5. And they braided a crown out of thorns, and put it on his head, and a reed in his right hand. And kneeling before him, they made fun of him, saying; Good day, you King of the Jews! (Matthew 27:29)

[Question] What did they put upon his head, mocking his kingship, and what would they do and say to him, mockingly?

6. And they started greeting him; Good day, you King of the Jews! (Mark 15:18)

[Question] What would the soldiers then mockingly say to Jesus?

- 7. And when he went in before her he said; Good day, highly favored one, Yehowah is with you. (Luke 1:28)
  - [Question] How differently did the angel address Mary, when first appearing to her?
- 8. After he said these things, one of the officers that was standing by, gave Jesus a slap in the face and said; Is that the way you answer the chief priest? (John 18:22)
  - [Question] How did one of the Jewish officers earlier treat Jesus, when the High Priest asked Jesus a question?
