

**John 19:30~** When, now, he had received the sour wine, Jesus said; **It has been accomplished! And, bowing his head, he delivered up his spirit.**<sup>1</sup>

*Footnote: Or, he stopped breathing Literally, he gave up the spirit Greek, pa·re'do·ken to pneu'ma*

**1· So then, as soon as Jesus had received the sour wine he said; It has been accomplished! Then bowing his head, he delivered up his spirit and died.**

**[Question]** What did Jesus then say, upon receiving the sour wine, for what was now complete?

**[Question]** What did he then do?

**2· I have glorified you on the earth, having finished the work you have given me to do. (John 17:4)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his father in prayer that he had accomplished through his ministry to Israel?

**3· If you conceal your face, they get disturbed. If you take away their spirit, they expire, and back to their dust they go. (Psalms 104:29)**

**[Question]** What happens to men, when Yehowah God takes away his spirit from them?

**4· For that reason, I shall deal him a portion among the many, and it will be with the mighty ones, that he will apportion the spoil, due to the fact, that he poured out his soul to the very death, and it was with the transgressors that he was counted in, and he himself carried the very sin of many people, and for the transgressors he proceeded to interpose. (Isaiah 53:12)**

**[Question]** Who would Jesus apportion spoil with, and why?

**[Question]** What did Jesus carry in behalf of the people?

**5· Again Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and yielded up his spirit. (Matthew 27:50)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus do, just before he expired?

**6· But Jesus let out a loud cry and expired. (Mark 15:37)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus do, just before he died?

- 7· And **Jesus** called with a loud voice and **said**; Father, into your hands I entrust my spirit. When he had **said** this, he expired. (**Luke 23:46**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus say just before he died, and with whom did he entrust his spirit, his life force?

- 8· And righteousness must prove to be the belt of his hips, and faithfulness the belt of his loins. (**Isaiah 11:5**)

**[Question]** How did Isaiah show how the Messiah would gird himself for the task of being the Messiah?

- 9· **Jesus said** to them; My food is for me to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work. (**John 4:34**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus consider the doing of Yehowah God will to be for him?

- 10· And I saw standing in the midst of the throne, and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, a lamb as though it had been slaughtered, having seven horns and seven eyes, which eyes mean, the seven **spirits** of God, that have been sent forth into the whole earth. (**Revelation 5:6**)

**[Question]** What vision of the Christ is shown in Revelation, and how does he appear there?

- 11· In that case, how would the Scriptures be fulfilled, that it must take place this way? (**Matthew 26:54**)

**[Question]** What was Jesus most concerned with accomplishing fully, by his life course toward Israel?
