1. Yet one of the soldiers, to be certain that he was dead, jabbed him in the side with his spear, and immediately blood and water came out.

[Question] What though, did a soldier do, to prove that Jesus was indeed dead, and what happened immediately, and what did this show?

2. But he was being pierced for our transgression. He was being crushed for our errors. The chastisement meant for our peace, was upon him, and because of his wounds, there has been a healing for us. (Isaiah 53:5)

[Question] Why was Jesus pierced, and why was his life crushed?
[Question] What has resulted for others through his chastisement and wounds he incurred?

3. And I will pour out upon the house of David and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem the spirit of favor and entreaties, and they will certainly look to the One whom they pierced through, and they will certainly wail over Him, as in the wailing over an only son, and there will be a bitter lamentation over him, as when there is bitter lamentation over the firstborn son. (Zechariah 12:10)

[Question] What had Zechariah prophesied would happen to the Messiah, that was fulfilled here by the soldier?

4. But the rest of them said; Let him be! Let us see whether Elijah comes to save him. Another man took a spear and pierced his side, and blood and water came out. (Matthew 27:49)

[Question] What did people then want to see, if it would happen?
[Question] What did a man, a soldier do to Jesus showing that he was already dead?

5. Consequently the other disciples would say to him; We have seen the Lord! But he said to them; Unless I see in his hands the print of the nails, and stick my finger into the print of the nails, and stick my hand into his side, I will certainly not believe. (John 20:25)
