

John 19:35~ And he that has seen it has borne witness, and his witness is true, and that man knows he tells true things, in order, that you also may believe.

1· So John was there, and he saw these things, and knew that Jesus his Lord had died, and he bore witness through his Gospel account, that he knew these things to be true, so that others might believe also through him.

[Question] What does John now bear witness, to as an eyewitness?

2· But these have been written down that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that, because of believing, you may have life by means of his name. (**John 20:31**)

[Question] Why did John write down these matters for future generations of men, for what flows outward from this knowledge?

3· This is the disciple that bears witness about these things, and that wrote these things, and we know, that the witness he gives is true. (**John 21:24**)

[Question] How did John bear witness, that he had seen and experienced these things himself?

4· That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have viewed attentively and our hands felt, concerning the word of life. (**1 John 1:1**)

[Question] How did John testify, that he had seen and touched, while he lived alongside of Jesus for several years?

5· Demetrius has had witness borne to him by them all and by the truth itself. In fact, we, also, are bearing witness, and you know that the witness we give is true. (**3 John 1:12**)

[Question] What did John also later bear witness to, in one of his letters?
