

**John 19:4~** And Pilate went outside again, and said to them; See! I bring him outside to you, in order for you to know, I find no fault in him.

- 1· So after this wrong treatment, Pilate came outside again to the Jews, and told them, that he still saw nothing deserving of death in him.

[Question] What did Pilate again come outside and say to the Jews about Jesus?

- 2· Then Pilate **said** to the chief priests and the crowds; I **find** no crime in this man. (**Luke 23:4**)

[Question] What crime did Pilate find within Jesus after questioning him?

- 3· Pilate **said** to him; What is truth? And after saying this, he **went out again** to the Jews and **said** to them; I **find** no **fault** in him. (**John 18:38**)

[Question] What did Pilate show, that he clearly did not understand?

[Question] Did Pilate find any fault deserving of death within Jesus after questioning him?

- 4· The one who did not **know** sin he made to be sin for us, that we might become God's righteousness by means of him. (**2 Corinthians 5:21**)

[Question] Who did Yehowah God make to be sin for men, and to what end result?

- 5· And, although they found no cause for death, they demanded of Pilate, that he be executed. (**Acts of Apostles 13:28**)

[Question] What did Pilate not find within Jesus, and yet did he stand up for justice, or what was right?
