- 1· Incidentally at the same place where he was impaled, there was a garden, and within the garden a new memorial tomb, one in which no one else had ever been laid, which had been quarried out of the rock mass.

[Question] What was also in the area of the burial plot, and what kind of a grave did Jesus have given to him?

- 2· And he will make his burial **place** even with the wicked ones, and with the rich class in his death, despite the fact, that he had done no violence, and there was no deception in his mouth. (**Isaiah 53:9**)

[Question] What had Isaiah said, about how the Messiah would be viewed in death, and who he would be buried among?

- 3· When, now, they had accomplished all the things written about him, they took him down from the stake and **laid** him in a **memorial tomb**. (**Acts of Apostles 13:29**)

[Question] What did they do to Jesus, after they ascertained that he was dead?

- 4· Hear us, my lord. A chieftain of God you are in the midst of us. In the choicest of our burial **places**, bury your dead. None of us will hold back his burial **place** from you, to prevent burying your dead. (**Genesis 23:6**)

[Question] How did the sons of Heth feel about Abraham, and what did they offer to him, to bury Sarah when she died?

- 5· And **laid** it in his **new memorial tomb**, which he had quarried in the rock-mass. And, after rolling a big stone to the door of the **memorial tomb**, he left. (**Matthew 27:60**)

[Question] Where was the grave of Jesus, and how was it made very secure?

- 6· Therefore she ran and came to Simon Peter and to the other disciple, for whom Jesus had affection, and she said to them; They have taken away the Lord out of the **memorial tomb**, and we do not know where they have **laid**

him. (John 20:2)

[Question] What did Mary Magdalene run and tell Peter and John, that she had just seen?
