And he entered into the governor's palace again, and said to Jesus; Where are you from? But Jesus gave him no answer.

1. So he entered again into the governor's palace and questioned Jesus, asking him, where he was from, but Jesus gave him no answer.

[Question] Where did Pilate then go, and what did he ask Jesus again, with what response?

2. He was hard pressed, and he was letting himself be afflicted, yet he would not open his mouth. He was being brought just like a sheep to the slaughtering. Like a ewe, that before her shearers has become mute, he also, would not open his mouth. (Isaiah 53:7)

[Question] How did Isaiah prophesy, about how the Messiah would react when before his opposers, and how did he illustrate this?

3. But, while he was being accused by the chief priests and older men, he made no answer. (Matthew 27:12)

[Question] What did Jesus say when being questioned by the chief priests and older men of the Jews?

4 Yet he did not answer him, no, not a word, so that the governor wondered very much. (Matthew 27:14)

[Question] Did Jesus then answer Pilate at all?

5. Now the passage of Scripture that he was reading aloud was this, As a sheep he was brought to the slaughter, and as a lamb that is voiceless before its shearer, so he does not open his mouth. (Acts of Apostles 8:32)

[Question] How did Phillip later show, that the prophecy of Isaiah applied to Jesus Christ?

6 But Jesus made no further answer, so that Pilate began to marvel. (Mark 15:5)

[Question] How did Pilate feel when Jesus made no answer, and did not even try to defend himself, though facing death unjustly?
