1. John begins his book truly at the beginning of creation, rather than at the start of Jesus' earthly life. Jesus was the first creation of Yehowah God, and the only direct creation by him, as is borne out in Colossians the First Chapter. So, before the creation of all other things, Jesus existed beside his heavenly father.

[Question] Where does John begin his story about Jesus Christ, and why there?
