

**John 1:11~****He came to his own home, but his own people did not take him in.**

**1· Jesus then came to his own home, in the sense, that he came to the Jewish nation, who had been a people in direct contact with him and his father for 1500 years, yet they rejected him, despite all of his fine works in fulfillment of prophecy.**

**[Question]** In what sense did Jesus come to his own home?

**[Question]** How though, did his covenant people treat him?

**2· But his citizens hated him, and sent out a body of ambassadors after him, to say; We do not want this man to become king over us. (Luke 19:14)**

**[Question]** How did Jesus illustrate, how the Jews had, and would treat Yehowah God's Son?

**3· I have become one estranged to my brothers, and a foreigner to the sons of my mother. (Psalms 69:8)**

**[Question]** How did the Psalmist show the feelings of the Messiah when among his people, Israel?

**4· What he has seen and heard, of this he bears witness, but no man is accepting his witness. (John 3:32)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus bear witness to, regarding heavenly things he knew of intimately, but did his countrymen, the Jews, accept that?

**5· And yet you do not want to come to me that you may have life. (John 5:40)**

**[Question]** What must men come to, so as to get life, for who alone is authorized to give life to men?

**6· Pilate answered; I am not a Jew, am I? Your own nation and the chief priests delivered you up to me. What did you do? (John 18:35)**

**[Question]** What did Pilate state to Jesus, showing he was not the one wanting to see him dead?

**7· What, then? The very thing Israel is earnestly seeking he did not obtain, but the ones chosen obtained it. The rest had their sensibilities blunted. (Romans 11:7)**

**[Question]** What had Israel been seeking for 1500 years, yet did the most of them attain to it?

**[Question]** What has happened to them as a result of their rejection of Christ, and their resulting rejection by Yehowah God?
