John 1:14~ So, the Word became flesh and resided among us,¹ and we had a view of his glory, a glory, such as belongs to an only-begotten son from a father, and he was full of undeserved kindness and truth.

1. So then, this Word of God, who had existed in heaven for eons of time before ever coming to the earth, became a man, and resided among mankind as a fleshly being. John then shows, that we had a view of his glory, though not the true fullness of that glory he has in heaven, and that it was the kind of fullness, that belongs to an only-begotten son from a father. Christ was full of undeserved kindness and truth.

[Question] Where did this Word of God originally reside, and for how long a time?

[Question] What then, did Jesus do, and how did John describe the glory he had?

[Question] What was Jesus Christ full of?

2. No, but he emptied himself, and took a slave's form, and came to be in the likeness of men. (Philippians 2:7)

[Question] How did Jesus accept, becoming less than his earlier heavenly glory, to help mankind?

3. Indeed, the sacred secret of this godly devotion is admittedly great. He was made manifest in flesh, was declared righteous in spirit, appeared to angels, was preached about among nations, was believed upon in the world, was received up in glory. (1 Timothy 3:16)

[Question] How important did Paul think that the coming of the Christ was, and how was this greatness made manifest among mankind?

4. Therefore, since the young children are sharers of blood and flesh, he also similarly partook of the same things, that through his death, he might bring to nothing, the one having the means to cause death, that is, the Devil. (Hebrews 2:14)

[Question] What did Jesus partake of, to become equal to his spiritual brothers?

[Question] What does the death of Jesus Christ bring to nothing over time?

5. You gain the knowledge of the inspired expression from God by this. Every inspired expression that confesses Jesus Christ as having come in the flesh, originates with God. (1 John 4:2)

[Question] What must every inspired expression coming from Yehowah God, confess?

6. For many deceivers have gone forth into the world, persons not confessing Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the antichrist. (2 John 1:7)

[Question] What had gone forth into the world of John's time, and what did those ones not confess about Jesus Christ?

[Question] How did John show, how to thus identify the antichrist?

7 For God loved the world so much, that he gave his onlybegotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him might, not be destroyed, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

[Question] What did the giving of Jesus Christ to the world as a sacrificial offering, and unblemished lamb, show to mankind?

[Question] What does everyone exercising faith in Jesus Christ gain through him?

8. By this the love of God was made manifest in our case, because God sent forth his only-begotten Son into the world, that we might gain life through him. (1 John 4:9)

[Question] How has the love of Yehowah God for mankind been made manifest to mankind, to what end?

9. Provided, indeed, that you heard him, and were taught by means of him, just as truth is in Jesus. (Ephesians 4:21)

[Question] What do we need to stay in union with Jesus Christ, for what is in Christ?

10" Let me refer to the decree of Yehowah. He has said to me you are my son. I, today, I have become your father. (Psalms 2:7)

[Question] What then, was this bread that he gave in beforehand of the life of the world?

21. Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth, listens to my voice. (John 18:37)

[Question] Why did Jesus state, that he had come into the world of mankind?

[Question] Who does anyone loving truth, stand with?

22. Concerning his Son, who sprang from the seed of David

according to the flesh. (Romans 1:3)

[Question] Whose physical seed, did Jesus Christ spring forth from?

23. For, there being an incapability on the part of the Law, while it was weak through the flesh, God, by sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and concerning sin, condemned sin in the flesh. (Romans 8:3)

[Question] What was the Law Covenant too weak to effect?

[Question] What did Yehowah God's sending of Jesus Christ condemn in the flesh?

24. But when the full limit of the time arrived, God sent forth his Son, who came to be out of a woman, and who came to be under Law. (Galatians 4:4)

25. But you did not learn the Christ to be so. (Ephesians 4:20)

30. Yes, the life was made manifest, and we have seen and are bearing witness and reporting to you the everlasting life which was with the Father and was made manifest to us. (1 John 1:2)

31. I know your deeds, look! I have set before you an opened door, which no one can shut, that you have a little power, and you kept my word, and you did not prove false to my name. (Revelation 3:8)

[Question] What did Jesus later tell the congregations in the Revelation account, to encourage them to maintain fine works?

32. And to the angel of the congregation in Laodicea write. These are the things that the Amen says, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation by God. (Revelation 3:14)

[Question] What is Jesus Christ before his creator, and when was he himself created?

33. And I saw the heaven opened, and, look! A white horse. And the one seated upon it is called Faithful and True, and he judges and carries on war in righteousness. (Revelation 19:11)

34 May the undeserved kindness of the Lord Jesus Christ be with the holy ones. (Revelation 22:21)
