John 1:16~ For we all received from out of his fullness, even undeserved kindness upon undeserved kindness.

1. John then shows, that all of Jesus' apostles and disciples received from out of his fullness, undeserved kindness upon undeserved kindness.

[Question] What did John then show, that Jesus gave to his disciples?

2. Because God saw good for all fullness to dwell in him. (Colossians 1:19)

[Question] Who did Yehowah God want all his own fullness to find expression in?

3. Carefully concealed in him are all the treasures of wisdom and of knowledge. (Colossians 2:3)

[Question] What are carefully concealed in Jesus Christ?

4. Because it is in him, that all the fullness of the divine quality dwells bodily. (Colossians 2:9)

[Question] What dwells bodily within Jesus Christ?

5. In praise of his glorious undeserved kindness, which he kindly conferred upon us, by means of his loved one. (Ephesians 1:6)

[Question] How did Yehowah God confer his glorious undeserved kindness upon men, through whom?

6' Through whom, we received undeserved kindness and an apostleship, in order, that there might be obedience of faith among all the nations, respecting his name. (Romans 1:5)

[Question] Why did Jesus Christ appoint apostles, or sent forth ones, to mankind?

7' By means of him we have the release by ransom through the blood of that one, yes, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his undeserved kindness. (Ephesians 1:7)

[Question] What do anointed Christians gain through Jesus Christ, and is this anything owed by God or Christ to men?

8. And to know the love of the Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness that God gives. (Ephesians 3:19)

[Question] What does the love of the Christ surpass, and what do anointed Christians gain, through their unity with Christ?

9. The undeserved kindness of our Lord Jesus Christ be with all of you. (2 Thessalonians 3:18)

**[Question]** What does Paul always ask to be with his anointed Christian brothers?

10" However, the undeserved kindness which he gives is greater. Hence it says; God opposes the haughty ones, but he gives undeserved kindness to the humble ones. (James 4:6)

[Question] Though Yehowah God is full of undeserved kindness, how does he feel about haughty men, so then, who alone obtains this undeserved kindness?
