John 1:17~ Because the Law was given through Moses, the undeserved kindness and the truth, came to be through Jesus Christ.

1 Now the firm commandments of the Law Covenant came to be through Moses, but John shows, that the undeserved kindness and the truth, came to be through his successor, the one greater than, but like Moses, Jesus Christ.

[Question] What did the firm commandment come through?

[Question] What though, came through the successor of Moses, the one greater than Moses, but like him?

 2. Now as soon as he had finished speaking with him on Mount Sinai, he proceeded to give Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone, written on by God's finger. (Exodus 31:18)

[Question] What did Yehowah God give to Moses there at Mount Sinai, and what created those tablets?

3. Now this is the Law that Moses set before the sons of Israel. (Deuteronomy 4:44)

[Question] What covenant, did Yehowah God use Moses to give to his people?

4. Moses gave you the Law, did he not? But not one of you obeys the Law. Why are you seeking to kill me? (John 7:19)

[Question] What did Jesus state about the origin of the Law Covenant, and Israel's compliance to it down through time?

5. And it is as a free gift that they are being declared righteous by his undeserved kindness, through the release, by the ransom paid by Christ Jesus. (Romans 3:24)

[Question] How does the undeserved kindness of Yehowah God come to anointed Christians, based upon what act of Jesus?

For sin must not be master over you, seeing, that you are not under Law, but under undeserved kindness. (Romans 6:14)

[Question] What must not become the master of anointed Christians, and why?

7. And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free. (John 8:32)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that they would truly come to know, through the Holy Spirit within them?

 3. Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. (John 14:6)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that he was to them?

[Question] Can anyone gain access to the Father, except through Jesus Christ, and is accurate knowledge of the truth essential for that?

9. Therefore Pilate said to him; Well, then, are you a king? Jesus answered; You yourself are saying that I am a king. For this, I have been born, and for this, I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone that is on the side of the truth, listens to my voice. (John 18:37)

[Question] What did Jesus tell Pilate that was the reason for his coming to the earth?

[Question] Who listens to the counsel and teachings of Jesus Christ?

10. For no matter how many the promises of God are, they have become Yes, by means of him. Therefore, also through him, is the Amen said to God, for glory through us. (2 Corinthians 1:20)

[Question] What come to true fulfillment through Christ alone?

11. These are the regulations and the judicial decisions and the Laws that Yehowah set between himself and the sons of Israel in Mount Sinai by means of Moses. (Leviticus 26:46)

[Question] How did Yehowah God establish his Laws and commandments toward Israel?

12. These are the commandments that Yehowah gave Moses, as commands to the sons of Israel in Mount Sinai. (Leviticus 27:34)

[Question] What was contained within the Law Covenant given to Moses?

13. Moses laid as a command upon us a Law, a possession of the congregation of Jacob. (Deuteronomy 33:4)

[Question] What did the Law Covenant become to the nation of Israel or descendants of Jacob?

14. He will send from heaven and save me. He will certainly confuse the one snapping at me. God will send his loving-kindness and his trueness. (Psalms 57:3)

[Question] What confidence did the Psalmist have in his God Yehowah?

15. God raised this One up on the third day, and granted him to become manifest. (Acts of Apostles 10:40)

[Question] What did Yehowah God do for Jesus Christ three days after his death, and to whom then did he become manifest?

16 On the contrary, we trust to get saved, through the undeserved kindness of the Lord Jesus, in the same way as those people also. (Acts of Apostles 15:11)

[Question] Though a Jew by birth, how did Paul expect to get saved, like who?

Yes, God's righteousness through the faith in Jesus Christ, for all those having faith. For there is no distinction. (Romans 3:22)

[Question] What comes to anointed Christians through their faith, and does this come to Jews as well as to Gentiles?

18. To what end? That, just as sin ruled as king with death, likewise also, undeserved kindness might rule as king through righteousness, with everlasting life in view, through Jesus Christ our Lord. (Romans 5:21)

[Question] What ruled over mankind from Adam to John the Baptist?

[Question] What now rules over mankind, and with what end in view?

19. I always thank God for you in view of the undeserved kindness of God given to you in Christ Jesus. (1 Corinthians 1:4)

[Question] Why was Paul always thankful to Yehowah God, for what did he see expressed within other's lives?

20" Consequently, let us keep the festival, not with old leaven, neither with leaven of badness and wickedness, but with unfermented cakes of sincerity and truth. (1 Corinthians 5:8)

[Question] What do anointed Christians have to keep the symbolic festival of the unfermented cakes with?

21. Thanks be to God for his indescribable free gift. (2 Corinthians 9:15)

[Question] How should anointed Christians feel upon receiving the anointing through Holy Spirit, for what is it in reality?

22. I do not shove aside the undeserved kindness of God, for if righteousness is through Law, Christ actually died for nothing. (Galatians 2:21)

[Question] What would it be, to think that righteousness came forth from the Law Covenant?

[Question] Would Christ's death then, be truly meaningful, if that was the case?

23. Why, then, the Law? It was added to make transgressions manifest, until the seed should arrive, to whom the promise had been made, and it was transmitted through angels, by the hand of a mediator. (Galatians 3:19)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God give the Law Covenant to men before the coming of the Christ, if the promise of the Christ is better?

24. May you have undeserved kindness and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 1:2)

[Question] What does Paul always wish for his anointed Christian brothers?

25. Made us alive together with the Christ, even when we were dead in trespasses, by undeserved kindness you have been saved. (Ephesians 2:5)

[Question] How did Yehowah God bring to life anointed Christians, and how has this come forth to them?

26. You, therefore, my child, keep on acquiring power in the undeserved kindness, that is in connection with Christ Jesus. (2 Timothy 2:1)

[Question] What did Paul tell Timothy to grow in always?

27. For the undeserved kindness of God, which brings salvation to all sorts of men, has been manifested. (Titus 2:11)

[Question] What was made manifest to all men, through the death of the Christ?

28. But have to do only with foods and drinks and various baptisms. They were legal requirements pertaining to the flesh, and were imposed, until the appointed time to set things straight. (Hebrews 9:10)

[Question] What did the commandments of the Law Covenant pertain to, and why were they given first?

29. Do not be carried away with various and strange teachings, for it is fine for the heart to be given firmness by undeserved kindness, not by eatables, by which, those who occupy themselves with them, have not been benefited. (Hebrews 13:9)

[Question] What should anointed Christians avoid, for what will truly give anointed Christians a firm faith?

30^{••} In fact, Moses said; Yehowah God will raise up for you from among your brothers a prophet like me. You must listen to him, according to all the things he speaks to you. (Acts of Apostles 3:22)

[Question] What promise did Yehowah God make through Moses, and who would this coming one be like?

31. Indeed, any soul that does not listen to that Prophet will be completely destroyed from among the people. (Acts of Apostles 3:23)

[Question] What would then happen, according to Moses, to any person who refused to listen to that prophet, the one like Moses?

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
