

John 1:18~ No man has seen God at any time. The only-begotten god¹ who is in the bosom position with the Father, is the one that has explained him.

Footnote: The only-begotten god P75!c; P66!*BC*, only-begotten god; AC^cItVgSy^{c,h}, the only-begotten Son

1· Then the apostle John shows us, that no man has seen God at any time. However it is the only-begotten god, his son Jesus Christ, who is in the bosom position with the father in heaven, that has accurately explained him to mankind, for he, is the Word of God, his spokesperson.

[Question] Has any man seen God, while a man?

[Question] Who has Yehowah God though sent to earth as a man to explain Yehowah God, for what is Christ before his God?

2· And he added; You are not able to see my face, because no man may see me and yet live. (Exodus 33:20)

[Question] What did Yehowah God state to Moses, that was not possible for any man to see, and still keep living?

3· Not that any man has seen the Father, except he who is from God, this one has seen the Father. (John 6:46)

[Question] What man alone had in the past seen God, and knew what he had previously seen in heaven, when he became a man on earth?

4· At no time has anyone beheld God. If we continue loving one another, God remains in us, and his love is made perfect in us. (1 John 4:12)

[Question] Has any man seen God while a man, even Jesus Christ?

[Question] How alone will Yehowah God remain within us, and what then will happen over time to us, because of his influence?

5· In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was with God, and the Word was a god. (John 1:1)

[Question] What was Jesus described as in the beginning of creation, and where was he, and what form was he in then?

6· Then I came to be beside him as a master worker, and I came to be the one he was specially fond of day by day, I being glad before him all the time. (Proverbs 8:30)

[Question] How did Jesus come to work beside his father in the creation, and how did he feel about this fine work?

- 7· There was reclining in front of Jesus' **bosom** one of his disciples, and Jesus loved him. (**John 13:23**)

[Question] Who did Jesus come to especially love, among his twelve apostles?

- 8· All things have been delivered to me by my **Father**, and no one fully knows the Son, but the **Father**, neither does anyone fully know the **Father**, but the Son, and anyone to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (**Matthew 11:27**)

[Question] Who then, knows the Father better than anyone else ever could, and who knows the Son best?

- 9· All things have been delivered to me by my **Father**, and who the Son is no one knows, but the **Father**, and who the **Father** is, no one knows, but the Son, and he to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (**Luke 10:22**)

[Question] What things have been delivered to Jesus Christ by Yehowah God?

[Question] Who knows Yehowah God best among all men?

[Question] Who knows the Christ best?

- 10· Beloved ones, now we are children of **God**, but as yet, it **has** not been made manifest what we shall be. We do know, that whenever he is made manifest, we shall be like him, because we shall see him just as he is. (**1 John 3:2**)

[Question] What are all anointed Christians through their spirit anointing?

[Question] Do anointed Christians understand presently, what that future form of life is like?

[Question] What though, do anointed Christians presently understand?

- 11· Hence Jacob called the name of the place **Peniel**, because, to quote him, I have **seen God** face to face, and yet my soul was delivered. (**Genesis 32:30**)

[Question] What did Jacob state, about a place he rested in, and why?

[Question] Did he really see the face of Yehowah God, or did he experience a closeness to Yehowah God through his spirit?

- 12· **And they got to see the God of Israel. And under his feet there was what seemed, like a work of sapphire flagstones, and like the very heavens for purity. (Exodus 24:10)**

[Question] What vision of Yehowah God's throne did the 70 elders of Israel behold, when the Holy Spirit came upon them?

- 13· **And Yehowah spoke to Moses face to face, just as a man would speak to his fellow. When he returned to the camp, his minister Joshua, the son of Nun, as attendant, would not withdraw from the midst of the tent. (Exodus 33:11)**

[Question] What does it mean that Yehowah God spoke to Moses face to face, did Moses actually see Yehowah God, or were they speaking directly in an open conversation?

- 14· **After that I must take my palm away, and you will indeed see my back. But my face may not be seen. (Exodus 33:23)**

[Question] What did Yehowah God tell Moses, that he would do in passing by Moses, to reveal himself to Moses?

- 15· **I shall see him, but not now. I shall behold him, but not near. A star will certainly step forth out of Jacob, and a scepter will indeed rise out of Israel. And he will certainly break apart the temples of Moab's head, and the cranium of all the sons of tumult of war. (Numbers 24:17)**

[Question] What did Moses prophesy in Numbers, about seeing this one?

- 16· **And Yehowah began to speak to you out of the middle of the fire. The sound of words was what you were hearing, but no form were you seeing, nothing but a voice. (Deuteronomy 4:12)**

[Question] When Moses spoke to Yehowah God at the thornbush, did he see any form there?

- 17· **Consequently Manoah said to his wife; We shall positively die, because it is God that we have seen. (Judges 13:22)**

[Question] What did Manoah and his wife think that they had seen, though it was an angel of Yehowah God?

- 18· **Look! He passes by me, and I do not see him, and he moves on, and I do not discern him. (Job 9:11)**

[Question] How did Job express how Yehowah God dwells and moves around men, without their knowledge?

- 19· **In the year that King Uzziah died I, however, got to see Yehowah, sitting on a throne lofty and lifted up, and his skirts were filling the temple. (Isaiah 6:1)**

[Question] What vision of Yehowah God's throne, was Isaiah privileged to view?

- 20· **And I proceeded to say; Woe to me! For I am as good as brought to silence, because a man unclean in lips I am, and in among a people unclean in lips, I am dwelling. For my eyes have **seen** the King, Yehowah of armies, himself! (Isaiah 6:5)**

[Question] How did this vision Isaiah saw, make him feel about himself?

- 21· **For there **has** been a child born to us, there **has** been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty **God**, Eternal **Father**, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)**

[Question] What does Isaiah show that the Son of God, this coming son, would come to be called, among several other roles?

- 22· **Now in course of time the beggar died, and he was carried off by the angels to the **bosom position** of Abraham. Also, the rich man died and was buried. (Luke 16:22)**

[Question] How did the parable of the rich man and Lazarus depict Yehowah God and those before him?

- 23· **Also, the **Father** who sent me **has** himself borne witness about me. You have neither heard his voice at any time, nor **seen** his figure. (John 5:37)**

[Question] Who bore witness on several occasions, that Jesus was the son of Almighty God?

[Question] What had certain Jews though, not seen or heard?

- 24· **I know him, because I am a representative from him, and**

that One sent me forth. (**John 7:29**)

[Question] Why did Jesus say, about why he was qualified to carry the message that Yehowah God had sent forth?

25· If you men had known me, you would have known my **Father** also. From this moment on, you know him, and have **seen** him. (**John 14:7**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that they had seen through knowing Jesus well, and why could he say this?

26· In answer Thomas said to him; My Lord and my God! (**John 20:28**)

[Question] What then, did Thomas reply, showing his acceptance of what Jesus said?

27· Now to the King of eternity, incorruptible, invisible, the only **God**, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen. (**1 Timothy 1:17**)

[Question] To whom, do glory and honor belong forever?

28· By faith he left Egypt, but not fearing the anger of the king, for he continued steadfast, as seeing the One who is invisible. (**Hebrews 11:27**)

[Question] How did Moses leave Egypt, and what did he not fear then?

[Question] Who though, did he then walk after, as if seeing him?
