1• John now reviews that witness, that John the Baptist gave to the priests and Levites, who came out to him from Jerusalem to ask him who he was.

2. Now as the people were in expectation, and all were reasoning in their hearts about John; May he perhaps be the Christ? (Luke 3:15)
