John 1:25~ So they questioned him and said to him; Why, then, do you baptize, if you yourself are not the Christ, or Elijah, or The Prophet?

1 So they asked him further, why he had come baptizing, if he was not the Christ, or Elijah, or The Prophet?

[Question] What question then did they ask of John the Baptist?

2. The baptism by John, from what source was it? From heaven or from men? But they began to reason among themselves, saying; If we say; From heaven. He will say to us; Why, then, did you not believe him? (Matthew 21:25)

[Question] What did Jesus later ask these men, as to the source of the works of John the Baptist?

3. They said; Some say; John the Baptist. Others; Elijah. Still others; Jeremiah or one of the prophets. (Matthew 16:14)

[Question] What was the common perception, as to who John the Baptist was among the common people?

4. Now as the people were in expectation and all were reasoning in their hearts about John; May he perhaps be the Christ? (Luke 3:15)

[Question] What were the people reasoning in their hearts, and why?
