- 3· They said; Some say; John the Baptist. Others; Elijah. Still others; Jeremiah or one of the prophets. (Matthew 16:14)**

[Question] What was the common perception, as to who John the Baptist was among the common people?

- 4· Now as the people were in expectation and all were reasoning in their hearts about John; May he perhaps be the Christ? (Luke 3:15)**
