

**John 1:29~** The next day, he beheld Jesus coming toward him, and he said; See, the Lamb of God, that takes away the sin of the world!<sup>1</sup>

**Footnote: Compare (John 3:16) Footnote**

**1·** The very next day John the Baptist beheld Jesus coming to him and he said to the crowds; See the lamb of God, that takes away the sin of the world! Thus he referred to Jesus Christ as a sacrificial lamb, like the ones offered twice daily at the temple in Jerusalem.

**[Question]** What did John the Baptist say when he saw Jesus coming to him?

**[Question]** What did this infer about Jesus, and his role before God?

**2·** Speak to the entire assembly of Israel, saying; On the tenth day of this month, they are to take for themselves each one, a sheep for the ancestral house, a sheep to a house. (**Exodus 12:3**)

**[Question]** What was offered for each ancestral house within Israel in the month of Abib each year?

**3·** He was hard pressed, and he was letting himself be afflicted, yet he would not open his mouth. He was being brought just like a sheep to the slaughtering. Like a ewe, that before her shearers has become mute, he also, would not open his mouth. (**Isaiah 53:7**)

**[Question]** How is Jesus course when before opposers, described in Isaiah, and what did Isaiah illustrate, that he would act like?

**4·** Clear **away** the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, according as you are free from ferment. For, indeed, Christ our Passover has been sacrificed. (**1 Corinthians 5:7**)

**[Question]** What are anointed Christians told to clear away from their lives completely, following their partaking of the emblems at the Memorial, and why?

**5·** But it was with precious blood, like that of an unblemished and spotless lamb, even Christ's. (**1 Peter 1:19**)

**[Question]** What was Jesus shed blood the equivalent of, and what was it foreshadowed by in ancient Israel?

- 6· **And I saw standing in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, a lamb, as though it had been slaughtered, having seven horns and seven eyes, which eyes mean the seven spirits of God, that have been sent forth into the whole earth. (Revelation 5:6)**

**[Question]** What vision is seen within Revelation, and what is there in the midst of the 24 elders, as if it had been slaughtered?

- 7· **Because of the trouble of his soul he will see, he will be satisfied. By means of his knowledge, the righteous one, my servant, will bring a righteous standing to many people, and their errors, he himself will bear. (Isaiah 53:11)**

**[Question]** How would the righteous one bring salvation to Yehowah God's people, and forgiven of their sins?

- 8· **For I handed on to you, among the first things, that which I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:3)**

**[Question]** Who died for the sins of anointed Christians?

- 9· **How much more will the blood of the Christ, who, through an everlasting spirit, offered himself without blemish to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works, that we may render sacred service to the living God? (Hebrews 9:14)**

**[Question]** How does the blood offered by Christ, cleanse anointed Christians from their sins, and to what end?

- 10· **He himself bore our sins in his own body upon the stake, in order, that we might be done with sins, and live to righteousness. And, by his stripes, you were healed. (1 Peter 2:24)**

**[Question]** Why did Jesus bear mankind's sins in his own body, and what has resulted for those appreciating this in faith?

- 11· **You know too, that that one was made manifest to take away our sins, and there is no sin in him. (1 John 3:5)**

**[Question]** What was the reason that Jesus Christ was made manifest to men, and what was he free of?

- 12· **I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If**

anyone eats of this bread he will live forever. For a fact, the bread that I shall give, is my flesh, in behalf of the life of the world. (**John 6:51**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus compare himself to, that the Israelites found in the wilderness, and what would become of anyone eating of his flesh symbolically?

**[Question]** What did Jesus state, that he gave his flesh to mankind for?

13· And he is a propitiatory sacrifice for our sins, yet not for ours only, but also for the whole world's. (**1 John 2:2**)

**[Question]** What does Jesus become for anointed Christian's sins, and also whose sins?

14· In addition, we ourselves have beheld, and are bearing witness, that the Father has sent forth his Son as Savior of the world. (**1 John 4:14**)

**[Question]** What do anointed Christians bear witness to, regarding why Yehowah God send forth his son into the world?

15· To this Abraham said; God will provide himself the sheep for the burnt offering, my son. And both of them walked on together. (**Genesis 22:8**)

**[Question]** How did the drama of Abraham and Isaac foretell the offering of Jesus Christ?

**[Question]** Who then, would provide the offering, the sheeplike one?

16· And he must have the bull taken out to the outskirts of the camp and must burn it, just as he burned the first bull. It is a sin offering for the congregation. (**Leviticus 4:21**)

**[Question]** How were these offerings mirrored within the Law Covenant?

17· But if he would bring a lamb as his offering for a sin offering, a sound female lamb is what he should bring. (**Leviticus 4:32**)

**[Question]** What kind of a lamb was to be offered up as a sin offering?

18· And he must bring his guilt offering to Yehowah for his sin

that he has committed, namely, a female from the flock, a female lamb or a female kid of the goats, for a sin offering, and the priest must make an atonement for him for his sin. **(Leviticus 5:6)**

**[Question]** What kind of lamb or goat was to be offered for guilt or sin?

- 19· He now went presenting the offering of the people, and took the goat of the sin offering that was for the people, and slaughtered it, and made an offering for sin with it as with the first. **(Leviticus 9:15)**

**[Question]** How was the goat of Azazel a prophetic picture of the offering of Jesus Christ?

- 20· Why did you not eat the sin offering in the place that is holy, since it is something most holy and he has given it to you that you may answer for the error of the assembly, so as to make atonement for them before Yehowah? **(Leviticus 10:17)**

**[Question]** How was the sin offering, to be viewed by the priests?

- 21· And the goat must carry upon itself all their errors into a desert land, and he must send the goat **away** into the wilderness. **(Leviticus 16:22)**

**[Question]** What would the second goat released to the wilderness, carry off with it?

- 22· Moses at once made a serpent of copper and placed it upon the signal pole, and it did occur, that if a serpent had bitten a man and he gazed at the copper serpent, he then kept alive. **(Numbers 21:9)**

**[Question]** What did Moses make for the people to look at, that foreshadowed the Messiah, and those putting faith in him?

**[Question]** What then, must men keep looking to in faith, to be preserved alive?

- 23· Things of error have proved mightier than I am. As for our transgressions, you yourself will cover them. **(Psalms 65:3)**

**[Question]** How did the Psalmist feel, when confronted with his own sinfulness?

- 24· In that day there will come to be a well opened to the house of David, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin, and for an abhorrent thing. (**Zechariah 13:1**)

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God state the Zechariah, that he would open for sin and for abhorrent things?

- 25· She will give birth to a son, and you must call his name **Jesus**, for he will save his people from their sins. (**Matthew 1:21**)

**[Question]** What was prophesied about Jesus before his birth, to his father Joseph?

- 26· That there might be fulfilled, what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet, saying: He himself took our sicknesses and carried our diseases. (**Matthew 8:17**)

**[Question]** How did Isaiah the prophet show, what Jesus would do for the people of Yehowah God?

- 27· And they began to say to the woman; We do not believe any longer on account of your talk. We have heard for ourselves, and we know, that this man is for a certainty, the savior of the world. (**John 4:42**)

**[Question]** What did Samaritan who heard Jesus preaching and teaching, quickly realize about this one?

- 28· And many people came to him, and they began saying; John, indeed, did not perform a single sign, but as many things as John **said** about this man, were all true. (**John 10:41**)

**[Question]** What did many say in comparison of John the Baptist to Jesus?

- 29· Why, then, the Law? It was added to make transgressions manifest, until the seed should arrive, to whom the promise had been made. It was transmitted through angels, by the hand of a mediator. (**Galatians 3:19**)

**[Question]** Why were men given the Law Covenant first, and how was this message from Yehowah God transmitted to mankind?

- 30· If we receive the witness men give, the witness **God** gives is greater, because this is the witness **God** gives, the fact

that he has borne witness concerning his Son. (1 John 5:9)

**[Question]** What witness did Yehowah God several times give concerning his son, Jesus Christ, and should men pay attention to this?

- 31· And every creature that is in heaven and on earth, and underneath the earth, and on the sea, and all the things in them, I heard saying; To the One sitting on the throne and to the **Lamb**, be the blessing and the honor and the glory and the might forever and ever. (Revelation 5:13)

**[Question]** How do all things living in heaven and earth, show honor for the Christ in heaven?

- 32· So right **away** I **said** to him; My lord, you are the one that knows. And he **said** to me; These are the ones that come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the **Lamb**. (Revelation 7:14)

**[Question]** Who today, have washed their garments, and will come out to salvation from the great tribulation, through their faith, by preaching the Good News of God's Kingdom worldwide?

- 33· And I saw, and, look! The **Lamb** standing upon the Mount Zion, and with him a hundred and forty-four thousand, having his name and the name of his Father, written on their foreheads. (Revelation 14:1)

**[Question]** Who are shown to be with the Lamb on Mount Zion, and how many of this smaller group are there?

- 34· And they are singing the song of Moses, the slave of **God**, and the song of the **Lamb**, saying; Great and wonderful are your works, Yehowah **God**, the Almighty. Righteous and true are your ways, King of eternity. (Revelation 15:3)

**[Question]** What are these true anointed Christians singing, and what message does it ring out with?

- 35· These will battle with the **Lamb**, but, because he is Lord of lords and King of kings, the **Lamb** will conquer them. Also, those called and chosen and faithful with him will do so. (Revelation 17:14)

**[Question]** Who will battle with the Lamb, when he take up his glorious power to rule the earth, yet how will all such ones end up?

**36· And he showed me a river of water of life, clear as crystal, flowing out from the throne of God and of the Lamb. (Revelation 22:1)**

**[Question]** Where does the river of water of life flow outward from?
