John 1:3~ All things, came into existence through him, and apart from him, not even one thing came into existence. What has come into existence.

1• All things that are a visible or invisible part of the creation came into existence through Jesus Christ, and not even one other thing came into existence apart from him. All the living creation, as well as the inanimate creation, were made at his hands.

[Question] What things visible and invisible came into existence through Jesus in his heavenly existence?

2. He was in the world, and the world came into existence through him, but the world did not know him. (John 1:10)

[Question] Where was Jesus in the First Century C.E, yet what did the world then not understand about him, and his past?

3. There is actually to us one God the Father, out of whom all things are, and we for him, and there is one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom all things are, and we through him. (1 Corinthians 8:6)

[Question]	How many God's are there in reality?
[Question]	Where do all created things come from?
[Question]	How many Lords are there in reality?
[Question]	What comes through Jesus Christ?

Because by means of him all other things were created in the heavens and upon the earth, the things visible and the things invisible, no matter whether they are, thrones or lordships or governments or authorities. All other things have been created through him, and for him. (Colossians 1:16)

[Question] How were all created things in heaven, and upon the earth, made?

[Question] Through whom, were all these things made, and for whom?

5. Has at the end of these days spoken to us by means of a Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the systems of things. (Hebrews 1:2) [Question] Who has Yehowah God made heir of all creation, and why?

6 And God went on to say; Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness, and let them have in subjection the fish of the sea, and the flying creatures of the heavens, and the domestic animals, and all the earth, and every moving animal that is moving upon the earth. (Genesis 1:26)

[Question] Whose image are men and women created in, and what do they have in subjection?

7 For your Grand Maker is your husbandly owner, Yehowah of armies being his name, and the Holy One of Israel is your Repurchaser. The God of the whole earth he will be called. (Isaiah 54:5)

[Question] What is Yehowah God in relation to the whole earth?

8 And Hezekiah began to pray before Yehowah and say; O Yehowah the God of Israel, sitting upon the cherubs, you alone are the true God of all the kingdoms of the earth. You yourself have made the heavens and the earth. (2 Kings 19:15)

[Question] What is Yehowah God, to all the kingdoms of the earth, and why rightfully so?

9. From time indefinite I was installed, from the start, from times earlier than the earth. (Proverbs 8:23)

[Question] When was Jesus installed in his role as the Word of God?

10. Then, I came to be beside him as a master worker, and I came to be the one he was especially fond of, day by day, I, being glad before him, all the time. (Proverbs 8:30)

[Question] How did Jesus come to work beside his father in heaven, and how did he feel about the creation?

11. Cry out joyfully, you barren woman, that did not give birth! Become cheerful with a joyful outcry, and cry shrilly, you that had no childbirth pains, for the sons of the desolated one are more numerous than the sons of the woman with a husbandly owner, Yehowah has said. (Isaiah 54:1) [Question] Why is God's woman told to cry out joyfully?
