

John 1:32~ John also bore witness, saying; I, viewed the spirit coming down as a dove out of heaven, and it remained upon him.

- 1· John the Baptist then bore witness, that he had viewed the spirit coming down out of heaven in the shape of a dove, and it remained upon Jesus.

[Question] What event did John the Baptist bear witness to the people, that he had seen, and where did it come to rest?

- 2· After being baptized Jesus immediately came up from the water, and, look! The heavens were opened up, and he saw descending like a dove, God's spirit coming upon him. (Matthew 3:16)

[Question] What did Jesus do immediately after being baptized, and what then happened to him?

- 3· And immediately on coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens being parted, and, like a dove, the spirit coming down upon him. (Mark 1:10)

[Question] What was then parted, and what came forth out of heaven and rested upon Jesus?

- 4· And the Holy Spirit in bodily shape like a dove came down upon him, and a voice came out of heaven; You are my Son, the beloved. I have approved you. (Luke 3:22)

[Question] What did the dove represent, that was then given to Jesus?

[Question] What did the voice out of heaven, then also state about Jesus?

- 5· And upon him the spirit of Yehowah must settle down, the spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the spirit of counsel and of mightiness, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of Yehowah. (Isaiah 11:2)

[Question] What had been prophesied by Isaiah to come upon Jesus, and what would then settle down upon him?

- 6· You have dispatched men to John, and he has borne witness to the truth. (John 5:33)

[Question] What did Jesus tell the Jews, and what witness had John the Baptist given respecting Jesus?

- 7· The **spirit** and the water and the blood, and the three are in agreement. (**1 John 5:8**)

[Question] What three witnesses bear witness, and concur about the Christ?

- 8· If we receive the **witness** men give, the **witness** God gives is greater, because this is the **witness** God gives, the fact that he has borne **witness** concerning his Son. (**1 John 5:9**)

[Question] How great is the witness given by Yehowah God with his own voice out of heaven, made on several occasions to Jesus Christ, in the sight of many?
