- Even I did not know him, but the very One who sent me to baptize in water said to me; Whoever it is, upon whom you see the spirit coming down and remaining, this is the one that baptizes in Holy Spirit.
 - 1. John then bore witness, that before this happened, he had no idea who this one was. Yet the one who sent him forth to go baptizing had told him, that the one upon whom you see the spirit coming down and remaining, this is the one that baptizes with Holy Spirit. And he had seen it, and so he was bearing witness.

[Question] What did John the Baptist bear witness to, for what had he been told to look for?

[Question] Who did he bear witness, that he had seen this spirit come down upon?

2. In the days of chief priest Annas and of Caiaphas, God's declaration came to John, the son of Zechariah, in the wilderness. (Luke 3:2)

[Question] Who was the High Priest of Israel, when John the Baptist started his ministry?

3. I, for my part, baptize you with water because of your repentance, but the one coming after me is stronger than I am, whose sandals I am not fit to take off. That one will baptize you people with Holy Spirit and with fire. (Matthew 3:11)

[Question] What did the baptism of John the Baptist symbolize to people undergoing it?

[Question] Who did John the Baptist state was coming, and what would he baptize with?

4 Because John, indeed, baptized with water, but you will be baptized in Holy Spirit not many days after this. (Acts of Apostles 1:5)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples a few days before Pentecost, and then would later happened there?

5. And they all became filled with Holy Spirit, and started to speak with different tongues, just as the spirit was granting them to make utterance. (Acts of Apostles 2:4)

[Question] What happened when Jesus' words were fulfilled upon his disciples?

And as for me, this is my covenant with them, Yehowah has said. My spirit that is upon you, and my words that I have put in your mouth, they will not be removed from your mouth, or from the mouth of your offspring, or from the mouth of the offspring of your offspring, Yehowah has said, from now on, even to time indefinite. (Isaiah 59:21)

[Question] What word did Yehowah God state, would not be removed from the mouth of his Messiah, or his offspring, to three generations?

7. The baptism by John, from what source was it? From heaven or from men? But they began to reason among themselves, saying; If we say; From heaven. He will say to us; Why, then, did you not believe him? (Matthew 21:25)

[Question] What did Jesus ask the religious leaders, to put them on the spot before the common people?

8. Jesus answered; Most truly I say to you, unless anyone is born from water and spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. (John 3:5)

[Question] What two births did Jesus show, that anyone must undergo to enter into the Kingdom of God?

9. At this I called to mind the saying of the Lord, how he used to say, John, for his part, baptized with water, but you will be baptized in Holy Spirit. (Acts of Apostles 11:16)

[Question] What did Peter bear witness to, upon seeing the Holy Spirit fall upon Cornelius and his family?

10" This is he that came by means of water and blood, Jesus Christ. Not with the water only, but with the water and with the blood. And the spirit, is that which is bearing witness, because the spirit is the truth. (1 John 5:6)

[Question] How do the three witness bearers, the water of baptism, the shed blood of Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit all bear witness about the Christ to confirm, that he is from Yehowah God?
