Andrew the brother of Simon Peter was one of the two that heard what John said, and followed Jesus.¹

Footnote: Literally, him

1. Now Andrew, the brother of Peter, was one of the two disciples of John the Baptist that heard what John had said regarding Jesus, and went with him. The other disciple is unnamed, but it was not Peter, Andrew's brother.

[Question] Who was one of the two disciples, that thus spoke to Jesus and followed after him initially?

[Question] Who is it clear, that the other one was not?

2' Walking alongside the sea of Galilee he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother, letting down a fishing net into the sea, for they were fishers. (Matthew 4:18)

[Question] What then, happened later, and were Andrew and Peter familiar with the work of Jesus, and who he was by then?

3. The names of the twelve apostles are these; First, Simon, the one called Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James the son of Zebedee and John his brother. (Matthew 10:2)

[Question] What are some of the names of the twelve apostles, and how many pairs of brothers were there among them?
