1· So Andrew led Peter to where Jesus was staying, and introduced him to the Lord. When Jesus looked upon Simon, he told him that from henceforth, he would be called Cephas, which translates into Greek as Peter.

[Question] Who then, did Andrew introduce to Jesus, and what did Jesus do to change Simon's name?

2· And because he was in no need to have anyone bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man. (John 2:25)

[Question] Why did Jesus not really need to hear the witness of men, for what did he know about man?

3· The names of the twelve apostles are these. First, Simon, the one called Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James the son of Zebedee, and John his brother. (Matthew 10:2)

[Question] Who are the first four mentioned of Jesus' disciples, and what were they toward one another?

4· Symeon has related thoroughly how God for the first time, turned his attention to the nations, to take out of them, a people for his name. (Acts of Apostles 15:14)

[Question] Why did Yehowah God turn his attention to the nations, through the anointing of Cornelius and his family?

5· In response Jesus said to him; Happy you are, Simon son of Jonah, because flesh and blood did not reveal it to you, but my Father who is in the heavens, did. (Matthew 16:17)

[Question] What did Jesus tell Peter, for who had revealed to Peter that Jesus was the Christ?

- 6· When, now, they had breakfasted, **Jesus said to Simon Peter; Simon son of John**, do you love me more than these? He **said** to him; Yes, Lord, you know I have affection for you. He **said** to him; Feed my lambs. (**John 21:15**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell Peter later that he must do, if he loved Jesus more than food?

- 7· Also, I say to you, you are **Peter**, and on this rock-mass I **will** build my congregation, and the gates of Hades **will** not overpower it. (**Matthew 16:18**)

[Question] Though the name Peter means Rock mass, who is the foundation cornerstone of spiritual Israel?

[Question] What will not overpower the Christ, and how had that been shown?

- 8· And the group of twelve that he formed were **Simon**, to whom he also gave the surname **Peter**. (**Mark 3:16**)

[Question] What did Jesus then rename Simon?

- 9· **Simon**, whom he also named **Peter**, and Andrew his brother, and James and **John**, and Philip and Bartholomew. (**Luke 6:14**)

[Question] Who were some of Jesus' first disciples, who all later became apostles?

- 10· Walking alongside the sea of Galilee he saw two brothers, **Simon** who is **called Peter**, and Andrew his brother, letting down a fishing net into the sea, for they were fishers. (**Matthew 4:18**)

[Question] Where were Andrew and Peter when Jesus called them to discipleship?

- 11· We have authority to lead about a sister as a wife, even as the rest of the apostles and the Lord's brothers and Cephas, do we not? (**1 Corinthians 9:5**)

[Question] Was Peter married, and can any Christian marry who wants to?

- 12· Then three years later I went up to Jerusalem to visit

Cephas, and I stayed with him for fifteen days. (Galatians 1:18)

[Question] Who did Paul himself later visit in Jerusalem three years after his conversion, and for how long?

13· However, when Cephas came to Antioch, I resisted him face to face, because he stood condemned. (Galatians 2:11)

[Question] How did Paul later openly reprove Peter, when Peter did not live in harmony with the teachings of the Christ?
