1. Then the next day Jesus desired to depart for Galilee, and so he found Philip, and then invited him to be his follower, to which he readily accepted.

[Question] Where did Jesus depart, for the next day, and who did he find there, and what invitation did he receive?

2 Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector, James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus. (Matthew 10:3)

[Question] What are the names of six of Jesus' disciples who became apostles?

3. Next, while passing along from there, Jesus caught sight of a man named Matthew seated at the tax office, and he said to him; Be my follower. Thereupon he did rise up and follow him. (Matthew 9:9)

[Question] Where was Matthew when Jesus encountered him, and what invitation, did Jesus then extend to Matthew?

4. These are the ones that did not defile themselves with women, in fact, they are virgins. These are the ones, that keep following the Lamb, no matter where he goes. These were bought from among mankind, as firstfruits to God, and to the Lamb. (Revelation 14:4)

[Question] Who do the anointed Christians follow solely, and so how can they be described as virgins?

[Question] What has the anointing through Holy Spirit bought them out from, and who are they now promised to in marriage?

5. Jesus said to him; Keep following me, and let the dead bury their dead. (Matthew 8:22)

[Question] What did Jesus tell a man, who wanted to go off and care for his aging father rather than follow Jesus?
