

**John 1:45~ Philip found Nathanael and said to him; We have found the one of whom Moses, in the Law, and the Prophets wrote, Jesus, the son of Joseph, from Nazareth.**

**1· So Phillip found Nathanael his friend and told him; We have found the one that Moses in the Law, and also the prophets wrote about, Jesus the son of Joseph from Nazareth.**

**[Question]** Who did Phillip immediately go to, and tell about the Messiah, Jesus, and what did he tell Nathanael?

**2· Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector, James the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus. (Matthew 10:3)**

**[Question]** Who are six of Jesus' disciples who later became apostles?

**3· Simon, whom he also named Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James and John, and Philip and Bartholomew. (Luke 6:14)**

**[Question]** Who were six of Jesus' disciples who later became apostles?

**4· And I shall put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed. He will bruise you in the head, and you will bruise him in the heel. (Genesis 3:15)**

**[Question]** What did the first prophecy in the Bible state, would always exist between the seed of Satan the Devil, and the seed of the woman, Jesus Christ?

**5· And by means of your seed all nations of the earth will certainly bless themselves due to the fact that you have listened to my voice. (Genesis 22:18)**

**[Question]** Who was Abraham told would bless themselves, and through whom?

**6· The scepter will not turn aside from Judah, neither the commander's staff from between his feet, until Shiloh comes, and to him, the obedience of the peoples will belong. (Genesis 49:10)**

**[Question]** Where did the Bible show, that the commander's staff would not turn aside from, until when, and what then would belong to this one?

- 7· **A prophet I shall raise up for them from the midst of their brothers, like you, and I shall indeed put my words in his mouth, and he will certainly speak to them, all that I shall command him. (Deuteronomy 18:18)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God promise to raise up within Israel, and who would this prophet be like?

- 8· **In fact, if you believed Moses, you would believe me, for that one wrote about me. (John 5:46)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell men, who said they believed in Moses?

- 9· **For there has been a child born to us, there has been a son given to us. The princely rule will come to be upon his shoulder. His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6)**

**[Question]** Who did Isaiah show, that Yehowah God would bring forth for his people to rule over them?

**[Question]** What roles, would this one later come to fill?

- 10· **In those days and at that time, I shall make sprout for David, a righteous sprout, and he will certainly execute justice and righteousness in the land. (Jeremiah 33:15)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God, through Jeremiah, state that he would raise up for his people Israel, and how would this one rule?

- 11· **And I will raise up over them one shepherd, and he must feed them, even my servant David. He himself will feed them, and he himself will become their shepherd. (Ezekiel 34:23)**

**[Question]** What shepherd did Yehowah God promise to raise up over his people, and what would this shepherd do for God's people?

- 12· **And you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, the one too little to get to be among the thousands of Judah, from you there will come out to me, the one who is to become ruler in Israel, whose origin is from early times, from the days of time indefinite. (Micah 5:2)**

**[Question]** Where would this shepherd king be born, and where was his true origin?

- 13· **And you must say to him; This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Here is the man whose name is Sprout. And from his own place he will sprout, and he will certainly build the temple of Yehowah. (Zechariah 6:12)**

**[Question]** What was this one also called, that translates to, Nazarene?

- 14· **Look! I am sending my messenger, and he must clear up a way before me. And suddenly there will come to His temple the true Lord, whom you people are seeking, and the messenger of the covenant in whom you are delighting. Look! He will certainly come, Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 3:1)**

**[Question]** What did Malachi show would come forth before this one?

**[Question]** Where would this one come to, and what would he carry with him foretold also by Jeremiah in (Jeremiah 31:31-35)?

- 15· **Jacob became father to Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ. (Matthew 1:16)**

**[Question]** Who were the mother and father of Jesus on earth?

- 16· **Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary, and his brothers, James and Joseph, and Simon and Judas? (Matthew 13:55)**

**[Question]** Whose son was Jesus widely known as, and what are the names of some of his family members?

- 17· **Of course, Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judea, to David's city, which is called Bethlehem, because of his being a member of the house and family of David. (Luke 2:4)**

**[Question]** Why did Joseph and Mary have to return to Bethlehem, where Jesus was then born, for where did they normally live?

- 18· **A prophet from your own midst, from your brothers, like me, is what Yehowah your God will raise up for you, to him, you people should listen. (Deuteronomy 18:15)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God, through Moses, tell the people of Israel, that he would raise up for them in time, and what prophet would he be like?

- 19· **Look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will raise up to David a righteous sprout. And a king will certainly reign and act with discretion, and execute justice and righteousness in the land. (Jeremiah 23:5)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God promise to raise up for David from his ancestral house?

**[Question]** What does the name sprout translate as?

- 20· **And came and dwelt in a city named Nazareth, that there might be fulfilled what was spoken through the prophets: He will be called a Nazarene. (Matthew 2:23)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus then later come to be called, and what word could we also call a Nazarene?

- 21· **And commencing at Moses and all the Prophets he interpreted to them things pertaining to himself in all the Scriptures. (Luke 24:27)**

**[Question]** What did Jesus later reveal to his close disciples about himself in the Bible record?

- 22· **There were in company Simon Peter and Thomas, who was called The Twin, and Nathanael from Cana of Galilee, and the sons of Zebedee, and two others of his disciples. (John 21:2)**

**[Question]** Who were there with Jesus, when he revealed himself to his disciples, on the Sea of Galilee, after his resurrection?
