John 1:46~ But Nathanael said to him; Can anything good come out of Nazareth? Philip said to him; Come and see.

1. However Nathanael was well versed in the scriptures, and so he asked, could anything good come out of Nazareth, for they all knew that the Messiah was to come out of Bethlehem in Judea. So he asked; Can anything good come out of Nazareth? So Phillip invited him to come and see for himself.

[Question] What though, did Phillip say, would be convincing enough evidence to persuade Nathanael?

2. Others were saying; This is the Christ. But some were saying; The Christ is not actually coming out of Galilee, is he? (John 7:41)
