- 1· Then as Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him, he said be him, that Nathanael was for a certainty, an Israelite, in whom there was no deceit.

**[Question]** What did Jesus say about Nathanael, as he approached to Jesus?

- 2· And because he was in no need to have anyone bear witness **about** man, for he himself knew what was in man. (**John 2:25**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus know, about what was within men, for did he read their thoughts and innermost feelings through the Holy Spirit?

- 3· And Yehowah went on to say to Satan; Have you set your heart upon my servant Job, that there is no one like him in the earth, a man blameless and upright, fearing God, and turning aside from bad? (**Job 1:8**)

**[Question]** What things did Yehowah God know, about the heart and feelings of the faithful man Job, that his own companions did not know?

- 4· Happy is the man to whose account Yehowah does not put error, and in whose spirit there is no deceit. (**Psalms 32:2**)

**[Question]** Who is described by the Psalmist as being happy, and why?

- 5· O do good, O Yehowah, to the good ones, even to the ones upright in their hearts. (**Psalms 125:4**)

**[Question]** Who will Yehowah God do good to, and why?
