

John 1:5~

And the light is shining in the darkness, but the darkness has not overpowered it.

- 1· **This glorious light shone in the darkness of a world of sinful men, beginning with the advent of Jesus Christ as a man on earth. Yet the darkness of sin and death, could not overpower it.**

[Question] Where was this glorious light shining, and what could not overpower it?

- 2· **And I myself have said; O, how I proceeded to place you among the sons, and to give you the desirable land, the hereditary possession of the ornament of the armies of the nations! And I further said; My Father, you people will call out to me, and from following me, you people will not turn back. (Jeremiah 3:19)**

[Question] What did Jeremiah witness to, that Yehowah God had given to his people Israel, and what did Yehowah God expect of them, as a result?

- 3· **Jesus therefore said to them; The light will be among you a little while longer. Walk while you have the light, so that **darkness** does not overpower you, and he that walks in the **darkness** does not know where he is going. (John 12:35)**

[Question] What did Jesus encourage his disciples to do, as long as they had this light among them?

[Question] What happens to men who try to walk about in the darkness?

- 4· **Now this is the basis for judgment, that the light **has** come into the world, but men have loved the **darkness**, rather than the light, for their works were wicked. (John 3:19)**

[Question] What then, is the basis of the judgment from Yehowah God, since this light has come into the world?

- 5· **Therefore Jesus spoke again to them, saying; I, am the light of the world. He that follows, me will by no means walk in **darkness**, but will possess the light of life. (John 8:12)**

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that he was, in the world?

6. **As long as I am in the world, I am the world's light. (John 9:5)**

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that he was, toward the world of mankind?
