

John 1:7~

This man came for a witness, in order to bear witness about the light, that people of all sorts might believe through him.

- 1· This man, John the Baptist, came to bear witness about this coming light from God, that people of all sorts might believe in God through him.**

[Question] What then did John the Baptist come to bear witness of, and why?

- 2· Listen! Someone is calling out in the wilderness; Clear up the way of Yehowah, you **people!** Make the highway for our God **through** the desert plain straight. (**Isaiah 40:3**)**

[Question] How did his coming also fulfill a prophecy in Isaiah?

[Question] What way was he to clear up, and where?

- 3· I, for my part, baptize you with water, because of your repentance, but the one coming after me is stronger than I am, whose sandals I am not fit to take off. That one will baptize you **people** with Holy Spirit and with fire. (**Matthew 3:11**)**

[Question] What did John the Baptist baptize with, yet who did he state was coming after him, and how would that one baptize?

- 4· Paul said; John baptized with the baptism in symbol of repentance, telling the **people** to **believe** in the one coming after him, that is, in Jesus. (**Acts of Apostles 19:4**)**

[Question] How did the apostle Paul later bear witness about John the Baptist?

[Question] Who did John the Baptist come before, and prepare a way for?

- 5· So they **came** to John and said to him; Rabbi, the man that was with you across the Jordan, to whom you have borne **witness**, see, this one is baptizing and all are going to him. (**John 3:26**)**

[Question] What did people convey to John the Baptist, after seeing many go over to become Jesus' followers?
